Institutional Research and Assessment

The teaching and learning process revolves around student assessment, which has been the subject of much discussion in the scholarship of teaching and learning. We can never know whether our teaching is effective without obtaining and analyzing evidence of student learning. Thus, effective instruction requires some means of knowing whether students are learning the required knowledge and skills. Assessing students' learning is like holding a magnifying glass up to their learning to determine whether it is working well or needs to be improved.

Assessing and evaluating the quality of academics and support programs for students is essential to University of the People's success. Assessing student learning outcomes at the program level continues to be a focus of the assessment team in the Office of Institutional Research and Assessment.

- Meet with BIOI 1121 instructors and inquire about their observations regarding the assignment. Also, analyze and assess the ratio of the sample size among both genders to determine if there was a balance between the two genders.
- Reassess the written assignment of measurement 1(HS 2212). The assignment was given in the very first week of the course. Since this work requires a comprehensive understanding of reading a study report and then generalizing the findings. Making students go through such tasks in week one can be a reason for failing to achieve the criteria of success. Such assignments should be introduced gradually, once the students are trained enough in reading and summarizing a study report.

2. Discussion Forums for MATH 1281 and MATH 1201 will be reviewed to enhance students' comprehension of the content. Instead of having open questions, a set of problems will be suggested for discussion.
3. The MATH 1281 - Introduction to statistics will be redesigned with better course learning outcomes and no advanced tools such as R or Math Lab or SPSS, etc.
4. Create instructor-graded assignments to measure the SLO in AY 2023 by improving the Learning Journal.
5. The learning journal for Math 1201 will be changed to engage students in the content of the lessons.
6. The MATH 1281 - Introduction to statistics will be redesigned with better course learning outcomes and to help students with advanced tools such as R or Math Lab or SPSS, etc. Learning journals will be improved to have better learning outcomes and help students understand the concept better.
7. Change the criteria for success from 70% to 75%
